§ 1 – Subject of Contract

The subject of this contract is the author's / the authors' work in the form of ready for press full papers, research-in-progress papers and extended abstracts submitted for the proceedings of the *Multikonferenz Wirtschaftsinformatik 2018* which are to be published online and/or in the printed conference proceedings.



§ 2 – Concession of Rights

The author is sole proprietor or the authors are joint exclusive proprietors of all rights to the work. They grant to the publisher, without any limitation as to country of publication, and for the period to which copyright legally applies, the right to reproduce and distribute (under the German laws of publishing) the work detailed in § 1 in the proceedings of *the Multikonferenz Wirtschaftsinformatik 2018*, together with any figures contained in the work, for all versions and editions, without limitation as to number of copies, and for all languages. They guarantee that sale or making available of the work will infringe neither the rights nor the claims of any third party, and that he/she/they has/have not exercised the rights in respect of the work in any other way, whether in whole or in part. In particular, the author assigns (the authors assign) the following rights of use over the work to the publisher, without limitation as to time, place or content:

- a) The book rights over the work, that is, the right to reproduce and distribute the work or edited forms of the work in all types of book for all versions and editions, and using all means of distribution, in particular general booksellers, book-related outlets, other retail outlets, book ordering services and similar.
- b) The database rights over the work, that is, the right to capture the work as machine-readable data, stored in any form whatever, and to edit it, in particular by enabling it to be accessed by means of software and by saving it on any type of data carrier, which carrier may be reproduced in any form and distributed, loaned or, further, transferred by remote data transfer (also referred to as downloading) to third parties (with their own rights); and the right of these end users to print out paper copies of the work.
- c) The author grants / the authors grant irrevocably to the publisher the right to archive and maintain the full text of the electronic version of his or her / their contribution indefinitely, using the services of the University's library, which will have the right to publish the text on its server for use on the Internet.
- d) The University's library is authorized to pass on the work with similar rights of promulgation to the Deutsche Nationalbibliothek (German National Library), and other academic libraries and to produce individual printed copies so that they may be preserved in the University's permanent archive.
